

Ladies' Two Ball Best-Ball Explained

2-Ball Best Ball involves teams of two golfers who play as partners, each playing her own golf ball throughout. We'll call the golfers on our example team Player A and Player B.

On each hole, players A and B each tee off. Each player continues to play their own ball until holed out.

At the conclusion of each hole, record the best GROSS score and the best NET score.

Each scorecard will be marked with the # of strokes to take off per hole based on your handicap.

- If Player A makes a 6 and she can take 2 strokes off, then her net score is 4.
- If Player B scores a 6 and she can take 1 stroke off, then her net score is a 5.
- So Player A scores 4 and Player B scores 5 therefore the team net score is 4.

Note: If you are out of a hole, meaning that you can no longer contribute to either the best gross or best net score, please pick up your ball.
