Turnout

- 53 players for 36 holes

Opportunities for Improvement:

- Dessert this year was disappointing...just keep on working with Restaurant staff on food.
- Reach out early to out-of-town players from past years. They appreciate an advance reminder
 - Phone, email, have an in-town friend contact them if we don't have contact info.
- A 'late registration' fee suggestion was made. Could have price at \$130 if registered no later than 2 weeks out. Then increase price by \$20 for entries after that. Idea is to increase early registration. This requires poster & pricing to be ready first week of July at the latest.
- Bringing our own sound system may be easier in the long-run....Tamara has one.
- Find a way to incorporate Caribou Rocks the North event into our timetable
 - Shotgun start on Saturday?
 - Late lunch/early dinner (1:30/2:00pm)
 - Prizes would have to be calculated afterwards & awarded Sunday OR find non-player volunteers to calculate pots/skins, etc.
- If giving prizes (instead of GCs) for course markers, have 2 or 3 options so people don't get the same items so many times.
- Skins & Deuces: create & provide Excel spreadsheet & laptop to volunteers (calculate prize amounts quicker)
